

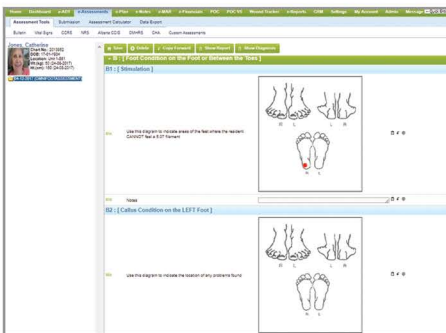


# Diabetic Order Sets

Are you confused about what an Order Set, Care Plan/Mapping/Pathways, Protocols-Processes, Guidelines, Best Practices etc. are when it comes to nursing?

In a nut shell, they are all the same. If your patient or resident has low blood sugar, what do you do? Usually give them orange juice and do their blood sugar again in 15 minutes. If your patient has a stage 3 Ulcer, what do you do? First, keep them off area; Second, rotate other areas Q2hr; Third, perform facility treatment protocol for stage 3; Finally, administer pain medication as ordered.

Intervention(s)	
-	PSW [1 intervention]
✗	Observe for signs of hypoglycemia, changes in LOC, cold and clammy skin, rapid pulse, hunger, anxiety, headache, agitation
-	Registered Nurse [1 intervention]
✗	Check blood sugar before breakfast
-	Family Practitioner/General Practitioner [3 interventions]
✗	Monitor kidney function
✗	Assess for neurological changes such as poor balance, numbness, neuropathic pain, etc.
✗	Consider smoking cessation program
